

How Do I Find a Good Therapist?

While there are a lot of therapists offering their services in our area, finding someone you like takes dedicated effort, especially if you have never seen a therapist before. It can be difficult to find a therapist who takes your insurance or is affordable, is in your geographic area, fits your schedule, has openings for new clients, *and* is someone you can work with. Fortunately there are plenty of options and tools to help!

Option 1 – Internet search

While just doing a blind search for a therapist on the internet can be overwhelming, there are online tools to make it easier. Navigate to <u>www.psychologytoday.com</u>, click the link at the top of the screen for **Find a Therapist**, and enter your zip code to view a list of all the therapists in that immediate area. You can then select criteria from the meu list on the left to narrow your search based on insurance, mental health issue, gender, sexuality, type of therapy, etc. From there, you can click on each therapist to read about their background, education, philosophy, availability, and cost. Once you've identified two or three potential options, you can reach out to them right from the website by email, or you can call them directly.

Option 2 – Counseling centers

Chittenden County has a number of counseling centers or affiliated groups of therapists. The therapists may all be located under one roof, or the center may have multiple locations throughout the county. Oftentimes, the center may be able to help you identify the counselor who they feel would be most beneficial to you before beginning therapy. The list of counseling centers in Chittenden County is at the end of this handout.

Option 3 – Personal assistance from our Care Coordinator

Our Care Coordinator, Lisa Anderson, is a Medical Social Worker with an extensive background in identifying services for patients. While she does not do ongoing mental health counseling, she is available to help patients through the steps of identifying and establishing with an outside therapist. If you would like Lisa's assistance in finding a therapist, ask your Primary Care Provider to refer you to Lisa for assistance.

Option 4 - Onsite therapy at Thomas Chittenden

Thomas Chittenden Health Center is very fortunate to have an in-house social worker, Liz Moss, LICSW, who provides ongoing counseling for clients here at our office. Because space is limited, priority is given to patients who are uninsured or underinsured, or who have significant issues that prevent them from seeking therapy outside of our office. Clients must be referred by their Primary Care Provider.

Remember that this is the first step on a multi-step journey! Above all else, for therapy to be successful, you must have a good rapport with your therapist. This can take time to develop. If you find that you are unable to develop that rapport and you don't feel like you are making headway, then it may be time to look for another therapist.
